

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF  
CERTAIN PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN THE TOWN  
OF NEWFIELDS UNDER THE AUTHORITY IN  
RSA 41:11 AND/OR 47:17, VII & VIII

SECTION 1

Be it ordained by the Selectmen of the Town of Newfields that on and after the 20th day of November, 1973, the operation on the following Class V highways of this town, namely: Oaklands Road, Mast Road, Old Lee Road (Otis Road), Bald Hill Road and Hall's Mill Road, of any vehicle or combination of vehicles exceeding the gross weight of ten (10) Tons is hereby prohibited.



SECTION 2

Exceptions to the foregoing load limitations may be granted by the Selectmen upon written application and a hearing, if in the opinion of the Board of Selectmen the proposed use will not damage the said highways.



SECTION 3

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, on conviction, be found guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.
